We foresee to enhance caretakers' satisfaction with care and to increase job-related skills of low skilled care workers.

OBJECTIVES

TENDER4LIFE can complement the existing projects by adding new and specific competencies about person-centered care, but also provide an innovative approach by introducing ICT into the training of elderly care workers, such as the online assessment tool and online training.
